- Oversaw the OHSU Tinnitus Clinic, tinnitus research, intraoperative neurophysiological monitoring and the Dangerous Decibels international noise induced hearing loss and tinnitus prevention program with materials now in 41 countries.
- Author of over 850 scientific publications and/or presentations across his fields of interest.
